## 2018 EVENING AUTOTEST SERIES

### SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

#### Introduction:

Following the ethos of "Grass Roots Motor Sport" all events are intended to provide a properly organised fun event for both the novice and expert and encourage juniors.

- 1 The Tunbridge Wells Motor Club will promote a Joint Permit Production Car/Clubsport Status Autotest on:  
Tuesday 1st May at Gabriels Farm, Edenbridge, Kent  
Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> June at Gabriels Farm, Edenbridge, Kent  
Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> July at Gabriels Farm, Edenbridge, Kent  
Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> August at Gabriels Farm, Edenbridge, Kent  
Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> September and at Gabriels Farm, Edenbridge, Kent.
- 2 The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd., (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these regulations and any other written instructions the organising club may issue for the events.
- 3 MSA Permit Number will be advised in due course.
- 4 The event is open only to all fully elected members of the Tunbridge Wells Motor Club and/or The Member Clubs of the ASEM.C.
- 5 All competitors must produce a valid Club Membership card at signing on (MSA competition licences are not required).
- 6 Production Car (Passenger Class) Autotest – Passengers must occupy the passenger seat at all times and wear a seat belt. (M16.1 & M16.2 MSA Year Book 2018). Entries may be accepted from Drivers who are 14 and over. However, for drivers 'not' holding a full RTA (Driving Licence), the passenger must hold a full RTA Licence and be experienced in Autotesting. The vehicle used 'must' be by definition a 'touring car' and not exceed 2000cc forced induction. (M17-2018 MSA year book). If the driver holds a valid non-provisional RTA Licence, the passenger must be 12 years or over and be at least 135cm in height. No other passengers are allowed. The Production Class is designed to help young or novice drivers.
- 7 The programme of the meeting is as follows:  
Tuesday events: Signing on starts at 6.30pm. First Car starts at 6.30pm. Any competitor not signed on by 7.30pm may be excluded from the meeting. Start may be earlier 7.00 if necessary.  
Sunday event: Signing on starts at 1.30pm. First Car starts at 2pm. Any competitor not signed on by 2.30pm may be excluded from the meeting.

- 8 There will be at least 6 tests on private land with at least 2 attempts at each test. Best time on each test to count towards the results. The entry will be split to start at different tests. Details of tests will available at signing on. Timing will be by hand held stop watch. The starting signal will be the drop of a marshal's arm.
- 9 The event will consist of the following classes, or at the organisers discretion to reflect the spirit of the event in the true TWMC ethos of "Grass Roots Motor Sport":
- A. Saloons up to 13ft overall length and saloons over 13ft up to 14ft 6 inches and over 1600cc.
  - B. Front wheel drive saloons over 13ft and up to 14ft 6 inches overall length, and under 1600cc.
  - C. Saloons over 14ft 6 inches overall length.
  - D. Rear wheel drive saloons up to 14ft 6 inches and Sports cars
  - F. Specials.

All vehicles must comply with MSA Technical Regulations applicable to Autotests.

As the event takes place on private land, vehicles need not have an Mot or tax.

It is the Drivers' responsibility to ensure that the vehicle they are driving is in a fully roadworthy condition and when signing they are confirming that fact.

- 10 Awards will be as follows:  
Awards will be at the discretion of the organisers and reflect the spirit of the event.
- 11 The entry list opens on publication of these regulations and finally closes 3 days before each event. The entry fee the event is £12.50, Students £7.50. Late entries will be accepted up to the date of the event but may be subject to a late entry surcharge of £2.50 may be applied. All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee.
- 11 The Secretary of the Meeting to whom all entries should be sent is:

- 12 The maximum entry for the meeting, including reserves, is 50. The Minimum for each class is 3. The minimum for the meeting is 10. Should any of the above minimum figures not be reached, the organisers have the right to either cancel the meeting or amalgamate the classes as necessary. Entries will be selected on a first come first served basis. Entry fees may be refunded if the Secretary of the Meeting is informed of a cancelled entry at least 48 hours before the start of the event, after this time refunds will be made at the organiser's discretion.

- 14 Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after the event and posted on the TWMC website two or three days after each event.
- 15 Any protests must be lodged in the Spirit of the Event.
- 16 Starting numbers may be advised by the organisers.
- 17 Competitors will be identified by Driver Name.
- 18 Marking will be elapsed time plus penalties as follows:  
Striking a bollard and or overshooting the finish: 10 seconds for each occurrence.  
Wrong route: Quickest time in class plus 30 seconds.
- 19 All other General Regulations of the MSA apply as written.
