



The Wells Run 2019

Sunday 18th August 2019

Welcome to The Wells Run organised by the Tunbridge Wells Motor Club.

The Wells Run will be a non-competitive navigational road run around Kent and East Sussex for classic and sports cars. The run will start in Tunbridge Wells with tea/coffee and a bacon roll before navigating its way through country roads and villages with a lunchtime break at Braylsham Castle, the home of ex F1 driver John Mew. The navigational run will then continue back to Tunbridge Wells where there will be a BBQ at the finish held at Team Dynamics in Bells Yew Green.

Regulations

1. The Tunbridge Wells Motor Club will organise "The Wells Run" a non timed touring assembly run on the 18th August 2019
2. The event will be held under a certificate of exemption touring assembly issued by the Motorsport UK. these Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event
3. The event is open to classic and sports cars which hold a V5 Registration Document with up to date vehicle tax and a valid MOT certificate where required
4. All drivers must hold a valid driving licence for the car being driven. A competition licence is not required
5. A basic vehicle eligibility and safety check may be carried out at the start. Any vehicle, which, in the opinion of the organisers, is deemed inappropriate or unsafe, will not be allowed to start.
6. All entrants must ensure that they have adequate insurance to enter the event, and they will be required to sign a declaration to this effect at the documentation check process. The event has no competitive element.
7. After documentation checks, entrants will be given their Rally Plate, Road Book, and Route Check Card.

Entries

Entries open on the publication of these regulations, and closes on Friday 10th August. All entries must be made on the official entry form either **on line** at www.twmc.org.uk or by post with the correct entry fee (cheques payable to The Tunbridge Wells Motor Club). Final Instructions will be posted to you during the week prior to the event with any additional information required. Updates will also be emailed to you.

The entry fee is £60 based on two people in a car, for additional passengers please add £15.00.

The maximum number of cars for this event is 50, entries will be selected in order of receipt, and the running order being decided by the organisers.

Any profits will be divided between the Tunbridge Wells Motor Club and the Kent & Sussex Air Ambulance

The Route

The start will be at the Royal Tunbridge Wells District Indoor Bowls Club, High Woods Lane Hawkenbury Tunbridge Wells Kent TN2 4TU

The route will cover about 100 miles with a lunchtime stop at Braylsham Castle before heading back towards Tunbridge Wells finishing at Team Dynamics International Ltd Court Lodge Down, Hawkenbury Road, Bells Yew Green TN3 9AP

At the Start

Signing on will be from 8.30am where you may be required to present your documents, once signed on you will be supplied with a rigid rally plate (and ties), which will need to be displayed on the front of your vehicle, a road book and vouchers.

The first Car will leave at 9.30, and then the others will leave at approximately thirty second intervals
